HOSPITAL/MEDICAL INSURANCE

The Department does not provide hospital/medical insurance coverage for people participating in sponsored activities. Participants are encouraged to obtain their own insurance coverage prior to the activity they take part in from their own insurance agency.

If a participant signs up for team sports, they must attend preliminary meets, the area/district meet and state tournament, no exceptions. All team events will be offered if there are enough players for a team.

The mission of Special Olympics is to provide year-round training and athletic competition in a variety of Olympic-type sports for **cognitively disabled individuals**. This program provides continuing opportunities to develop physical fitness, prepare for entry into school and community sports programs, develop courage, experience joy, and participate in the sharing of gifts, skills, and friendship with their families, other Special Olympians, and the community.

Requirements: **Cognitively challenged, 8 years of age or older**. There is no upper age limit. Generally participants have IQ of 80 or less, and must be diagnosed with a cognitive disability.

1. Register with the West Bend Recreation Department by completing the form on the next page.
2. A physical/parent release form will be sent to you from the Therapeutic Coordinator after your registration form as been completed and returned.
3. Medicals must be completed by deadlines or participation is not allowed per state registration rule.
4. Physical form needs to be submitted or changed if medical information should to be updated.
5. Athletes **must be 8 years of age or older**. There is no upper age limit.
