

REGULATIONS FOR PLANTING STREET TREES

Trees may not be planted closer than:

- 1. 20 feet to a utility or street lighting pole. Only Flowering Crabtree varieties, Japanese Tree Lilac, or other low growing trees are allowed under power lines.**
- 2. 5 feet to a fire hydrant.**
- 3. 25 feet to the intersection of sidewalks at a street intersection.**
- 4. 15 feet to a driveway or alley.**
- 5. 35 feet to another tree, including trees on private property.**
- 6. 5 feet from a buried utility service lateral.
(This will not be known until after diggers hotline marks utilities)**
